Cabo Blanco Nature Reserve

The Cabo Blanco Nature Reserve at the very southern tip of the Nicoya Peninsula is one of the most scenically beautiful areas of the country. Enjoy a guided tour and walk into Cabo Blanco, the very first protected area in the history of Costa Rica and one of the best places to explore the wonders of the tropical forest. The forest is home to a large variety of animals like the white-tailed deer, pacas, armadillos, anteaters, howler and capuchin monkeys, racoons and coatis. There are also wild cats like ocelots, jaguarundis and margay cats.
